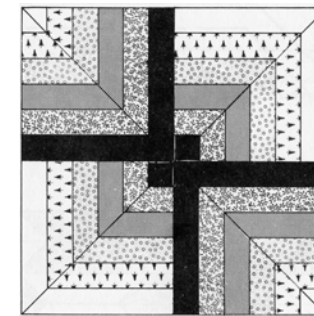
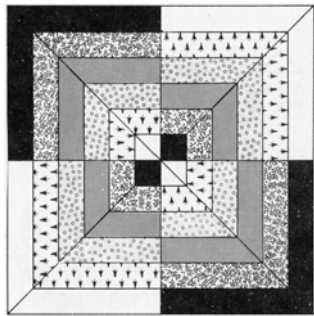


Annual Events
